Dear Parents/Guardians,

RESUMPTION OF SCHOOL DENTAL SERVICE PROGRAMMES IN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS DURING PHASE 3 (HEIGHTENED ALERT)

- 1 As a follow-up to the letter dated 24 June 2021, we wish to inform you that the School Dental Service (SDS) will resume services in Term 3 in a phased approach:
 - a. Dental clinics in selected schools would have re-opened in the first two weeks of Term 3.
 - b. The remaining school dental clinics will re-open by mid August 2021.
- 2 In the interim period, we appreciate your understanding to seek dental attention using these channels:
 - a. Students in schools with operating dental clinics who *require dental attention* may contact the dental clinic to request for an appointment.
 - b. Students with *dental emergencies* (e.g. severe pain affecting sleep, facial swelling due to dental infection, dental injury) in schools without operating dental clinics may call for an appointment to be seen at the School Dental Centre* in HPB
