Dear Parents/Guardians

Our 2024 Year Theme is "Be True, Pure, Strong and Brave" takes reference from our Theme Verse:

I asked our girls at the start of Term 4 – How would you like to feel at the end of 2024? I wish them joy with purpose and hope for the future, at the end of 2024 and always. Our girls could articulate that their mindsets and attitudes are key for this desired feeling. At my Final Assembly Sharing today, I encouraged our girls to reflect and be truthful of their current mindsets and attitudes, and intentionally use the school holidays to nurture more positive mindsets and attitudes (e.g. use growth mindset language more, surround oneself with positive people, set realistic goals, learn something new, focus on health etc.) so as to better prepare themselves for an even more awesome 2025.

Indeed we end the year with joyful and grateful hearts. We thank God and look forward to 2025. Come 2025, I am most excited by our refined time-table so that school can end by 2pm for our lower secondary girls and earlier than 3.10pm for some of our upper secondary girls. I look forward to strengthening our school-parent partnership in 2025, and to journey together into our blessed 110th Year in 2026.

The following are some things for you to take note of as the academic year draws to an end. More importantly, at this year-end, please take time to celebrate your daughter/ward's learning and growth.

1. S1-2 Bridging & Remedial Programme and Sec 3 Remedial Programme and Selfpaced Learning (28 Oct to 8 Nov)

The objectives of bridging and remedial is to help our girls address their learning gaps, and better prepare themselves for the next learning year. Selected Sec 1 to 3 girls have been informed by their subject teachers and were given a schedule for bridging and/or remediation lessons via email for (28 Oct to 1 Nov) the upcoming holidays. Please check with your child if she is required to attend.

In addition, we also encourage our Sec 3 students to continue their self-paced learning programme (28 Oct to 8 Nov) in the upcoming holidays, details have been assigned to them via their SLS and/or Google classroom groups. Completing this learning responsibly will provide our girls with a stronger foundation for their Sec 4 curriculum next year.

b. School Uniform Purchases

Considering the ongoing hot weather and to ensure the safety and well-being of students, the school will continue with our dress-down policy into 2025. From Monday to Friday, students may wear dress-down attire, including a school-based t-shirt with skorts or pinafore as a more comfortable option. However, full school uniform with the school tie will still be required on special occasions such as Founder's Day, Graduation Day, Class Photo taking, and other formal events.

Some students have outgrown their uniforms and have been adjusting them during the school day by unbuttoning or unzipping due to discomfort. With the upcoming school holidays, the Singapore Police Force (SPF), Central Narcotics Bureau (CNB), National Crime Prevention Council (NCPC), and National Council Against Drug Abuse (NCADA) would also like to remind all students about the consequences of committing crimes and engaging in drug/inhalant abuse. It is essential to take preventive measures to avoid becoming victims of crime. In addition, the Health Sciences Authority (HSA) and Health Promotion Board (HPB) would like to raise awareness among students about the harmful effects of using imitation tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and e-vaporizers.
