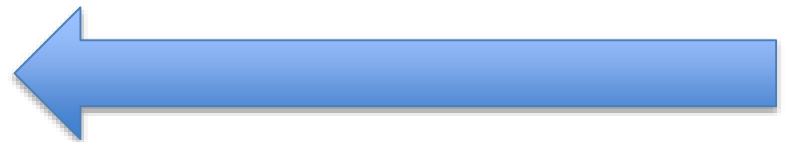

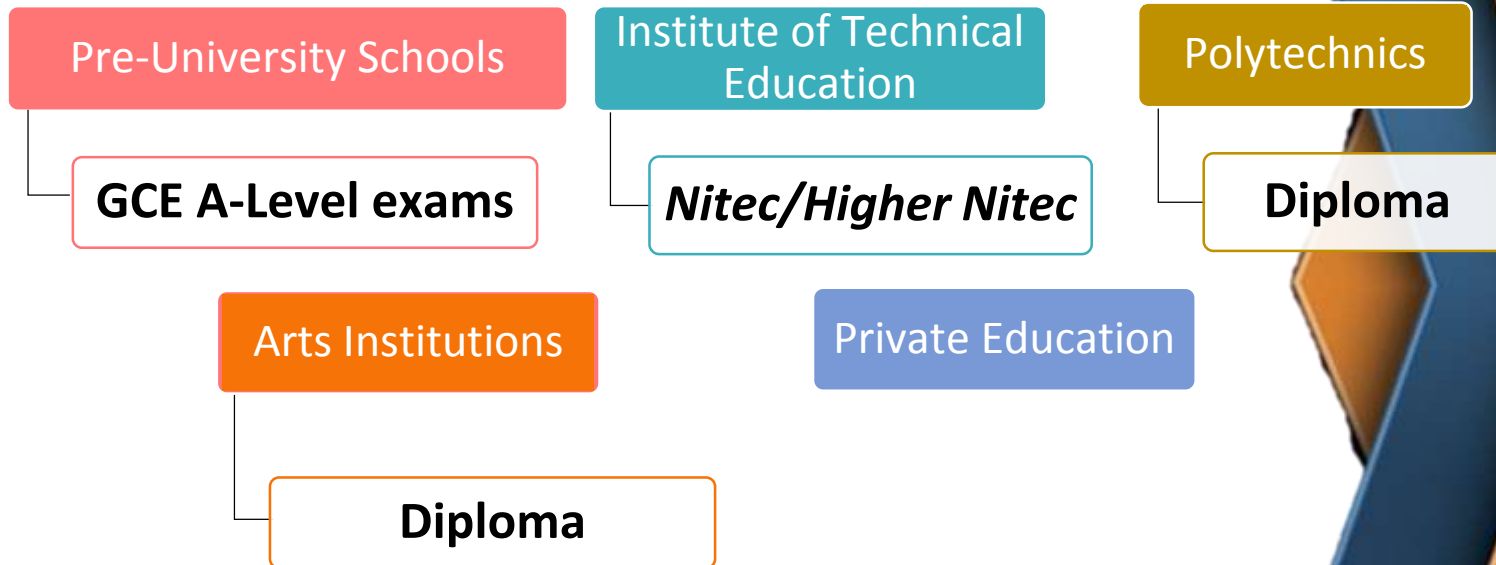

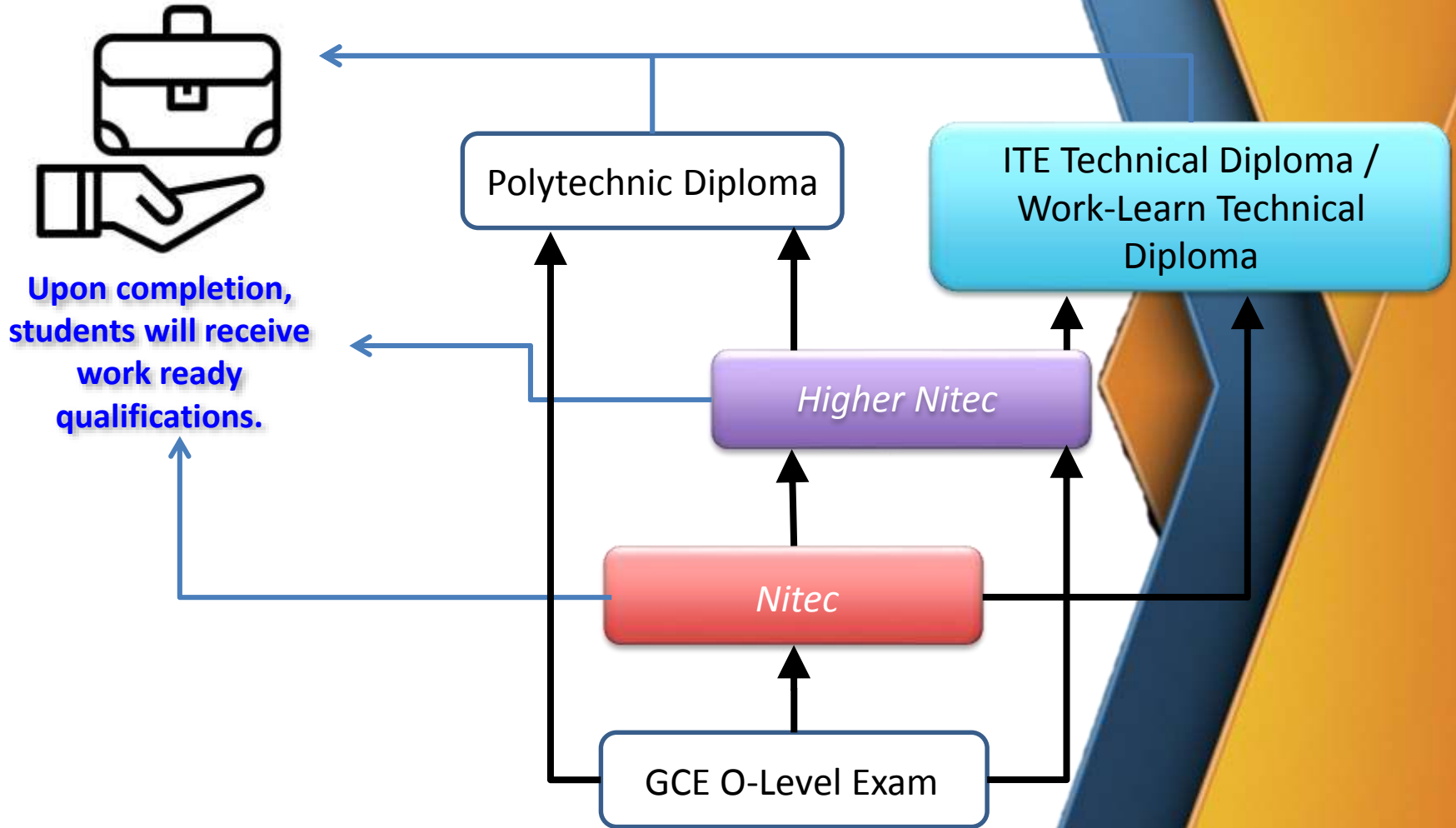

# JAE 2019 POSTING RESULTS



Students who are offered a course in a **JC/MI** must **report to** the school on the date stipulated.

Students who are offered a course in a **Poly/ITE** should expect to receive an enrolment package and are required to complete **online enrolment** by the date stipulated to confirm your acceptance for the course of study.

**Students who fail to report to the JC/MI/Poly/ITE on the stipulated dates are deemed to have forfeited her place.**
