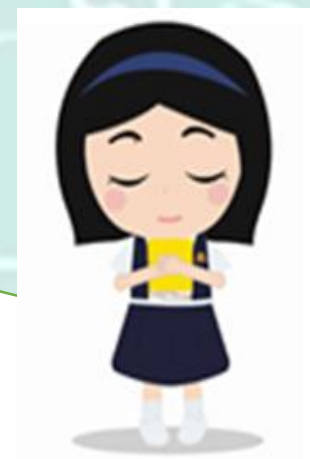
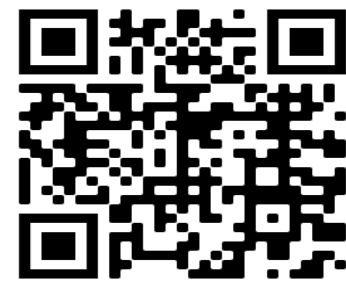
PL21 Quick Bites Tips on Note-Taking for students

Learning by annotating

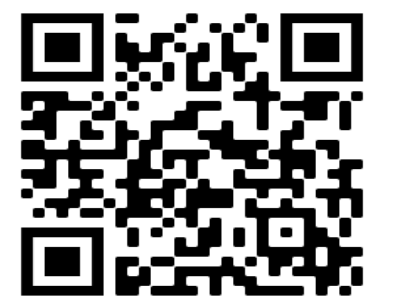
Annotating helps you *identify questions, confusing language, and important ideas or words* that support deepened thinking. This *will allow you to make connections with what you are reading.*

Method 1: Outline system

A more effective way of note-taking is by *sieving and writing down outlines* of the main points *in bullet form*

Method 3: Flow-Based Note-Taking

In Flow-Based Note-taking *you write down major ideas rather than paragraphs and sentences*

Once you have some ideas written down, *you connect them by drawing few arrows, pictures and diagrams to connect them to each other as related concepts*
